- 2. Why do you think John suggests repentance as a way to prepare for Jesus' arrival?
- 3. What does it look like to bear good fruit?
- 4. Why is bearing good fruit an important component of being ready for Jesus?

We do some of the work in preparing ourselves for Jesus' arrival, but God does a lot of the heavy lifting for us. God has created each of us with gifts and talents for service. God loves us and forgives us – all of the time. God creates a clean heart in each of us.
