1. How would you describe John's frame of mind from the way his question is asked?
2. Instead of a direct answer, what sort of message does Jesus send back for John?
3. What about the people of this time made them especially hungry for a message of hope?

1. Why is Hope such an important virtue to you right now in your life?
2. Where do you find, or who inspires the most fuel for your own Hope?
3. Who do you feel called to help inspire Hope in this week?
