- 1. How does Mary's actions at the tomb vary from those of Peter and John?
- 2. What does Mary's response to the angels reveal about her thoughts and emotions?
- 3. Do you feel that Mary is excited to turn the page to a new chapter of faith, or is she being dragged into it? What makes you see it that way?
