#### Mark 9:2-9

The Transfiguration is an important event that we celebrate every year in our liturgical calendar, and for good reason. Although the event itself is obviously focused on Jesus, the story of the event is a great opportunity to explore the disciples' reactions and how we can relate to them.

- 1. How would this event be so much more potent than the previous miracles they had witnessed?
- 2. In v6, Peter was so terrified that he did not know what to say. Why do you think he was still compelled to say something?
- 3. The disciples have been following Jesus for a while and after this event he tells them not to talk about it. In what way do you think this event helped energize them for the challenges ahead?
- 4. [Bonus question] Read 2 Corinthians 4:3-6. How does Paul's description about the light shining out of the darkness relate to both the Transfiguration and to ourselves?

Going through a huge challenge can leave us weak and speechless. Being able to endure and thrive is crucial for us to stay supportive of ourselves and those around us in need.

- 1. In what way is the light of Christ within each of us the key to persevering?
- 2. Why is it important that we shine that light to others in need?
